

## **HIHR BARN RULES**

- WAIVERS MUST BE SIGNED BY ALL PERSONS PARTICIPATING IN ANY HORSE ACTIVITIES. NO EXCEPTIONS. (Blank waivers can be found outside the office or contact management)
- NO boarders in the feed room at any time. HIHR staff will feed as directed. Any changes must be submitted to the manager in writing and feed changes will be issued prior to the next feeding.
- Respect the all HIHR Policies, they are in place to keep everyone safe!
- RESPECT each other. There will be zero tolerance for bullying, slander or foul language. Any issues must be addressed to management immediately and will be dealt with accordingly.
- Any use of any equipment other than your own is strictly prohibited.
- The Leyen's private barn and tack room is strictly off limits.
- Visitors are always welcome but enter at their own risk. Visitors are the sole responsibility of the HIHR client and HIHR reserves the right to remove anyone from the facility at any time.
- Any equipment used (ie: jumps) must be put back in their designated storage space after use.
- Clean up after yourself. Do not leave tack, belongings or a mess at any time in the facility. We will not clean up after you or your horse!
- HIHR staff takes no responsibility for your belongings going missing. Any items found out of place will be put in the lost and found bin at the office.
- **Hours of operation are 10am-5pm** (with the exception of clinics and other events as well as extended hours for HIHR boarders and members)
- Notify management in writing if you wish to be on the farrier list. If you are unable to attend that farrier visit, there will be a \$25 handling fee that must be submitted prior to the appointment.
- Access to any other outbuilding on the premises is strictly prohibited. Private property.
- Please park courteously in the designated parking area only.
- NO SMOKING, DRUGS OR DRINKING OF ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE TOLERATED
- Helmets are strongly recommended for all riders but must be worn on any rider under the age of 18. No exceptions.
- Please use proper ring etiquette. If you do not know what this is, we will be happy to educate you!
- Lessons will take priority however lessons riders will follow courteous ring etiquette in order to accommodate everyone.
- NO lunging in the indoor arena EVER or in any other arena while it is rider occupied. Please use round pen.
- **NO Dogs**. On the property or in the barns.
- If you are the last to leave, please shut off the lights and close the doors.

- If you would like to look around the grounds, please find a person in a “CREW” shirt to help you! We will happily show you around and introduce you to our farm and animals.
- If you are here attending a clinic to audit or to ride/participate, we ask that you **PLEASE SIGN A WAIVER**. Waivers can be located under the mailbox next to the office door or on the home page of the HorseInHandRanch.com website; all completed waivers can be put in the mailbox, slid under the office door or emailed to HorseInHandRanch@gmail.com.
- Please be aware of all signs on the property that indicate **NO TRESPASSING, PRIVATE, OR QUARENTINE**. Do not enter any buildings without consent or with any of these signs. A facility fine of \$250 will apply to anyone caught trespassing.
- Children must be attended/supervised at all times. Please do not allow running around during the events.
